Fumi Johns Stewart is Executive Director of [The World Peace Prayer Society](#) promoting **MAY PEACE PREVAIL ON EARTH** activities worldwide. She was born in Tokyo, Japan and grew up with a sincere wish to bridge the two cultures of her American and Japanese parentage. Fumi was instrumental in introducing the Japanese based May Peace Prevail On Earth movement to the international community in the early 1980's. She brought [The Peace Pole Project](#) out of Japan, and helped to establish the international Peace Pole Movement.

Fumi assisted in opening the International Headquarters of The World Peace Prayer Society which was registered as a non-profit corporation in the state of New York in 1988. She also serves as US liaison to sister organization Goi Peace Foundation of Japan.

Peace Poles are now recognized as the most prominent international symbol and monument to peace. Peace Poles bear the message, May Peace Prevail on Earth in the languages of the world. It is estimated that there are more than 200,000 Peace Poles that have been dedicated in nearly every country on earth.

Fumi assisted the community of Ixtapa Zihuatanejo with the design of its Peace Pole Monument in Olof Palme Park.
